Curate's Corner - Rev Coryn Stanforth

At the end of May I spent a week on placement at Norwich Cathedral as part of my curacy. The Cathedral kindly lends curates a studio flat just outside the Cathedral Close for the duration of their placement.

Each day began with Morning Prayer at 7.30am. About a dozen people, including the clergy of the Cathedral Chapter, gathered in the quire. When you enter, the Cathedral is in darkness; the lights are only put on just before the service begins. It is a time of quiet contemplation and prayer and one where you appreciate being in an ancient place of worship and prayer

Many more people attend Evensong each day. This is sung by the Cathedral choir and is a beautiful and reflective end to the day. The worship brings together music, scripture and prayer. In terms of attendance, it is the Cathedral's fastest growing service. As part of my placement, I was able to see the boy choristers rehearsing. They were focussed and concentrating hard at 8am; a full school day would follow before they returned to the Cathedral to sing Evensong.

The ethos of the Cathedral is based on its Benedictine foundation. For its first 450 years the Cathedral was a Benedictine monastery. The Cathedral has three key values: worship, hospitality and learning. Morning Prayer and Evensong are part of the regular rhythm of worship in the Cathedral. There were also daily eucharists, as well as the main Sunday eucharist and also a magnificent celebration of Ascension Day.

A significant part of the placement involved meeting some of the many people who enter the building during an ordinary week. The Cathedral offers hospitality to its visitors. Tourists are returning and are greeted by welcomers. It was lovely to see familiar faces from the Tas Valley volunteering as Cathedral welcomers. I was also able to spend time with a volunteer chaplain. The chaplains are available if people want to have a chat and also pray with visitors when this is requested.

The focus on learning can most clearly be seen in educational visits to the Cathedral. I was able to assist with a visit for a primary school group who were doing a comparative study between the Cathedral and a mosque. All visiting the Cathedral are welcome to learn by participating in a guided tour of the building. If this is something you have not done, I heartily recommend it. Tours are free and take place on the hour; no booking is required.

It was a fascinating week and has left me with much to reflect on.

We are in the middle of Summer 2022 and I do hope you are all enjoying what summer brings along with it. Do look after yourselves and use adequate sun protection factor and ensure adequate hydration.

I have chosen a rather sensitive topic this time. As the Safeguarding lead for children and adults in the practice, I do have a role that brings mixed emotions with it. There is strong sense of wanting to prevent any harm happening to our patients. This is done through adequate training, ensuring that policies and processes are in place and that staff can bring to our attention any concerns they have noted during their interaction with patients. Prevention of harm is always the best policy. Yet on the other hand, I am aware that this can cause massive stress to all concerned. The important baseline message is that everyone should feel safe. Hence my choice of subject this time – Domestic abuse or violence. The UK government's definition of domestic violence is 'any incident or pattern of incidents of controlling, coercive, threatening behaviour, violence or abuse between those aged 16 or over who are, or have been, intimate partners or family members regardless of gender or sexuality. The abuse can encompass, but is not limited to psychological, physical, sexual, financial, emotional.'

There is help and it is readily available 24 hours. I am adding the numbers that anyone can access if concerned.

999 – ask for the police if worried about immediate danger

Ask for ANI codeword - If you are experiencing domestic abuse and need immediate help, ask for 'ANI' in a participating pharmacy. 'ANI' stands for Action Needed Immediately. If a pharmacy has the 'Ask for ANI' logo on display, it means they're ready to help.

Safe Places – can be in a shop like boots, an office, station or library. Find your safe place at <https://www.norfolk.gov.uk/safety/safe-places/about-safe-places/find-a-safe-place>

If you are concerned that a new, existing or former partner may have an abusive past, you can ask the Police to check records under the Domestic Violence Disclosure Scheme (also known as Clare's law).

It is everyone's right to be safe in every way.

- In partnership with the YMCA a weekly youth club is now running at the Village Centre on Wednesday evenings between 6 and 8pm. The youth club is for children aged 8-16years and is initially free of charge to those attending.
- A meeting is scheduled for Tuesday 28th June at 7pm at the Village Centre to discuss the development of a skate park. Please come along and find out more about this exciting project. There will be examples of possible designs to see and you can tell us what you would like the skate park to include.

Jubilee Trees for Norfolk - 40,000 cut price trees up for grabs in Norfolk

More than 40,000 trees are available at a discount for everyone across Norfolk, thanks to the launch of a new scheme in the county.

The Jubilee Trees for Norfolk are supporting the Queen's Green Canopy – a scheme to coincide with the celebrations to mark the Queen's Platinum Jubilee – where people from across the UK are invited to 'plant a tree for the Jubilee'.

Half-price tree packs will be available at seven tree collection points including Norwich (County Hall and Broadland Country Park), Acle, Long Stratton, Watton, Fakenham and King's Lynn). Applications are open from 30 May 2022 and the packs will be ready for collection in the planting season between December 2022-February 2023.



The Jubilee Trees for Norfolk scheme is being funded to a total of £50,000 Norfolk County Council and the Government through the Trees Outside Woodland project.

In the 2021/22 planting season, the 1 Million Trees team enabled nearly 45,000 trees to be planted through a range of innovative projects. Now the team is launching new initiatives to get even more trees planted in the 2022/23 planting season.
